The Annual Member's Award is given to acknowledge an individual who is recognized for their outstanding contributions to CCIAA and the field of Crime and Intelligence Analysis during the past year.

The Annual Innovations Award is given to acknowledge an individual for their innovative use of the Crime and Intelligence Analysis process during the past year.

Below are the nomination guidelines:

1. The nominee is someone who you believe has substantially contributed to the growth of our profession over the past year.
2. Nominations must be submitted by August 1, 2008. The nominations should be sent to your CCIAA Board Member who will be responsible for collecting nominations. The submittals must be in "publication ready" format and should include the following:
  - The award nominee's full name
  - The award nominee's correct job title
  - The name of the award nominee's agency
  - A short but detailed description of the award nominee's contributions to crime analysis over the past year
3. Submissions received after August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008 will not be accepted
4. Information regarding the nominee's and their contributions will be posted on our website in late August. At that time, I will send an email to the membership announcing that the voting for the awards has begun. The voting will run through September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2008. 5. The Award recipients will be announced at our 2008 Training Conference in Pleasanton, CA. The Training Conference will be held September 23- 26, 2008.
